Resolution on the Hanover County Republican Committee's Support for the Right-to-Work Amendment to the Virginia Constitution**

- Whereas the Republican Creed states, in part, "That the free enterprise system is the most productive supplier of human needs and economic justice" and that the principles of Right to Work foster the free enterprise system;
